

Check List for Portfolio Submissions

Bible:

Pick one-

- Sample of memory verses learned
- Sample of Bible worksheet
- Sample of art work showing understanding of Bible story
- Something from your curriculum showing work being done

Math:

- 3 samples of worksheets or photocopies of pages done in math book
- page your child is currently working on in their math curriculum

Optional-

- a sample of a test taken
- a sheet showing math tests taken and the scores

PE

- Log of physical activity
- a list of activities that were done to meet the other learning outcomes in PE besides the number of hours of physical activities (ex.- films watched, discussions on nutrition or fair play)

Optional

- Letter from a coach
- a photocopy of any certificates received (ex. Swimming level)
- a picture of your child playing a sport

CAPP

- list of activities that were done to cover the PLO's that were not mentioned in your weekly emails. (ex. – see PE)
- sample of worksheets done to specifically cover CAPP required PLO's for your child's grade

Fine Arts / Applied Skills

___ 3 samples of work they have done (ex – paintings, pictures of creations that can't be mailed such as foods prepared, cars fixed, or pottery made)

___ List of books read, discussions or films viewed that show that the PLO's are being met.
